Overland roads are well-developed, but in Kampala, while most streets are paved they are sometimes in poor condition and some side streets remain unpaved. Traffic volume in the city area is very high and prone to congestion, so it is recommended to seek accommodation close to the workplace. Housing with international standards is available in Kampala. The supply situation is excellent. Medical care is very good. There are international schools and numerous recreational opportunities (sports facilities, public hotel pools, gyms, cinema, a wide range of cultural offerings, and excursion destinations).
